Denmark

All 5 districts in Denmark transferred from DDF 25,400 dollar to Polio + After the match from the World Fund and from Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation the amount will be more than 1 million Danish kroner. It was publish october 24. CONGRATULATION ROTARY DENMARK !

District 1462 Lithuania

Transferred on line more than 20 % DDF donation for End Polio Now = 4869 dollar. CONGRATULATION !

Norway

Tønsberg Rotaryclubb together with 4 other clubs in the district revaccinated over 450 persons in the main street of Tønsberg. They did this in collaboration with health professionals and the local council. The first 200 was vaccinated for free and the other payed 300 N kroner. Fantastic project.
