# Hva er Polio?

- Virussykdom forårsaket av «Poliovirus»
  - Smitter ved «direkte» kontakt, «fekal-oral» og nærdråpe
  - Inkubasjonstid 1-2 uker
  - Symptomer
    - 90 % asymptomatisk eller lette symptomer
    - < 1% utvikler meningitt og lammelser
  - Ingen spesifikk behandling
  - Vaksine utviklet og tatt i bruk i 1956
  - Siste innenlandssmitte i Norge i 1969
  - 1988: WHO vedtok plan for global utryddelse
- Postpoliosyndrom
  - Senskader rammer 5-10 %



## POLIO + PREVENTION

Polio is a crippling and potentially fatal infectious disease. There is no cure, but there are safe and effective vaccines. The strategy to eradicate polio is therefore based on preventing infection by immunizing every child until transmission stops and the world is polio-free.

## HISTORY OF POLIO

In the early 20th century, polio was one of the most feared diseases in industrialized countries, paralyzing hundreds of thousands of children every year. Soon after the introduction of effective vaccines in the 1950s and 1960s however, polio was brought under control and practically eliminated as a public health problem in these countries.

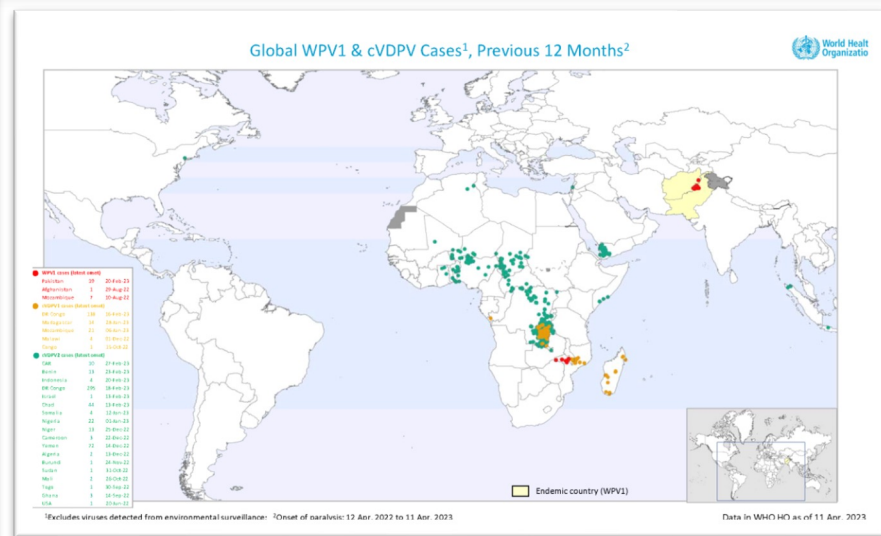

**5 REASONS WHY WE MUST ERADICATE POLIO**

- 1 TO IMPROVE LIVES.** Today, 10 million people who would otherwise be paralyzed by polio are walking, and 1.5 million people who would otherwise have died are alive.
- 2 TO INVEST IN THE FUTURE.** If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year. A polio-free world will be a healthier world for children everywhere.
- 3 TO IMPROVE CHILD HEALTH.** Polio surveillance networks and vaccination campaigns also monitor children for other health problems, like vitamin deficiency and measles, so we can address them sooner.
- 4 TO LOWER HEALTH CARE COSTS.** The global effort to eradicate polio has already saved more than \$27 billion in health care costs since 1988, and expects to save \$4 billion more by 2020.
- 5 TO MAKE HISTORY.** Polio eradication will be one of history's greatest public health achievements, with polio following smallpox to become only the second human disease eradicated from the world.

**FUNDING IS CRUCIAL TO ERADICATING POLIO**

Throughout the fight to end polio, we've learned what can be done when we draw on our collective strength. A polio-free world is possible, but we can achieve it only by taking action together.

More than 90 million children appear polio-free each year.	More surveillance systems to detect and respond to polio outbreaks at the earliest possible moment.	More than 100,000 health workers are trained to spot for the early signs of polio.

If polio isn't eradicated, within 10 years, hundreds of thousands of children could be paralyzed. Global health care costs would rise dramatically, and the quality of life for people affected by the disease would be drastically diminished.

  - WHO jobber med sine partnere for å støtte opp under arbeidet med «å komme tilbake på sporet» for å sikre at flere mennesker kan unngå forebyggbare sykdommer
  - Bistå lokal helsetjeneste slik at de får re-etablert vaksinasjonsprogrammer
- Noen nøkkelfakta
  - I 2021 hadde antall uvaksinerte barn økt med 5 millioner i forhold til 2019
    - Ca. 25 millioner barn under 1 år mottar ikke basis vaksinasjon (høyeste antall Siden 2009)
  - Antall jenter vaksinert mot HPV (humant papilomavirus) har økt med >3,5 millioner sammenlignet med 2019
- Er du «revaksinert»?
  - FHI anbefaler at alle voksne tar oppfriskningsdoser av trippelvaksinen mot difteri, stivkrampe og polio hvert tiende år

- Hvorfor skal vi markere dagen?
  1. «Den menneskelige kostnaden»

  2. «Det er oppnåelig»

Vi har effektive vaksiner til «End Polio Now» som kan gis til alle barn.
  3. «Det er en god investering»

Polio er sykdommen som ikke kan behandles, kun forebygges. En poliofri verden vil redusere kostnader med 40-50 mrd dollar de neste 20 årene.
  4. «Det styrker systemene»
